General regulations:	Only those skiers who are named by the respective club for the Austria Cup by means of an official entry list in good time are eligible to participate. For all competitions that are also categorised as Austrian Championships, the entry must be confirmed by the respective national ski association. Registration for the FIS competitions is only possible through the national ski association. All competitors must be Ski Austria members or in possession of a valid FIS code and provide proof of race risk accident insurance. A valid Ski Austria Card will be checked at random.
Realisation:	The competitions are organised in accordance with the provisions of the Ski Austria competition regulations (WO) and the FIS rules (IWO). In addition, the implementation regulations of the Cross-Country Skiing Austria Cup 2024/25 apply
Notes:	The organising club and its officials accept no liability for accidents, including towards third parties.
Wax:	<p>Please note the ban on fluorine waxes that has been in force since last season as well as the regulation regarding standardised wax that has been in force since this year!</p> <p>(For more details, please see the Organising Regulations)</p> <p>The Austrian Ski Association expressly points out that only ski waxes that comply with the REACH Regulation (Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006) may be used at the event. Violations of the legal provisions and the consequences thereof shall be borne in full by the person responsible.</p>

Provisions of the GDPR - Information on the processing of personal data

Information about sports results management:

Based on the consent of the data subject pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR or the fulfilment of a contractual or legal obligation of the controller pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b and c or f GDPR the personal data of the data subject, insofar as these are required for performance/results recording or results management in connection with registration or participation in (sporting) events or competitions, are processed and also stored and made publicly accessible in accordance with Art. 17 para. 3 in conjunction with Art. 89 GDPR for archiving purposes in the public interest and legitimate interests of the controller.

Information on audio and video recordings:
